Princes Pier Project Update September 2011

Princes Pier refurbishment

Progress on the refurbishment of Princes Pier continues. The current focus is on the restoration works to the gatehouse, which are well under way, and the project is currently on track to be completed in late 2011.

Installation of services to Princes Pier in Pier Street

The exploratory works to the footpath along the south side of Pier Street have taken longer than expected, however the Contractor is now ready to start installation of the sewer pipeline. This will be followed by the installation of water and gas pipelines.

The construction phase is expected to last for approximately 6 weeks. All efforts are being made to ensure the duration of work is kept as short as possible to minimise disruption and inconvenience.

Pier Street drainage works

Geotechnical site investigations have been completed. Simpson Construction Company has completed a major portion of the demolition and boring works along the footpath and across the promenade. The palm trees have been temporarily relocated to First Point Park and will be replanted on Pier Street following completion of the drainage works in December 2011.

Major Projects Victoria continues to monitor these works through detailed discussions with the Project Manager and Simpson Construction Company, and no delays have been reported to date.

Access and traffic management

The services and drainage works in Pier Street are being coordinated to minimise inconvenience to residents. An integrated traffic management plan is currently in place to maintain the best possible access along the street during these works.
